




Minutes of the Meeting

The minutes of the meeting were as follows:

1. Confirmation of the Minutes of the previous meeting:

The minutes of the last meeting held on 31 March, 2018 were read and confirmed. The members in charge of items decided in the last meeting reported the progress made on each item.

- Dr. P. A. Patil presented the outline of the workshop on soft skills to be organized by English department. Dr. Hirdekar recommended to incorporate the feedback of HRs of companies while deciding the content of the workshop.
- After the discussion, the name 'Vivek Mahotsav' was finalized for the intercollegiate mega-event to be organized by the college on the lines of events of some major autonomous colleges in the country.
  - It was decided to organize a workshop and competition on 'How to prepare a project report' in August under Entrepreneurship Development Programme. Dr. Hirdekar suggested to select and sell the dynamic project proposals to willing entrepreneurs for start-up business.

### 2. Action Plan 2018-19:

i) It was resolved to organize two health check-up camps during the year.

- ii) Mr Medshinge suggested that students can be adopted by the college for higher education. Prin. Dr. Hongekar told that such steps have been taken by the college earlier and the responsibility of documentation of such efforts of the college was given to Dr. Satish Gaikwad.
- lt was resolved to organize a music concert of passed-out students of Cultural Department CoC on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2018, death anniversary of Sansthamata Sushiladevi Salunkhe as a part of Shikshanmaharshi Dr. Bapuji Salunkhe Birth Centenary Celebrations.

iv) It was decided to conduct an orientation programme for teachers on preparing mooc material.

viii) It was resolved to design and implement a one-month spoken English course for non-treaching staff.

- x) It was decided to conduct a three day Personality Development Camp with a minimal fee and external experts and make it a special feature of the college.

3. College Discipline:

- i) Prin. Dr. S. Y. Hongekar put before the committee that the uniform of white shirt and dark pant for male teachers and that of pink saree or dress for female teachers was finalized and was made compulsory for two days in a week.
- Mr. C. B. Dodmani put forward the wish of non-teaching staff (Class IV) for the change in the colour of their uniform. Considering the suggestion, it was decided to select the colour after discussion with the concerned staff.
- iii) Prin. Dr. S. Y. Hongekar informed the committee the software enabling teachers to take attendance on their mobile phones was purchased by the college.
- iv) Dr. Hirdekar proposed to have vehicle record of the campus as that will help to minimize the possible trouble of external elements. If possible passes can be issued to vehicle owners.

4. Any other matter with the permission of the chair:

Ms. Madhura Kulkarni proposed that a workshop on YouTube Channel Making can be conducted.

ii) Dr. Joshi underlined the need of Hygiene Awareness Campaign for girl students including a lecture of personal hygiene awareness for girls.
