- I) Entrance Exam: -
 - The entrance examination will be conducted as per the notification.
 - The fees for entrance examination will be as mentioned in advt.
 - The entrance examination fee once paid is non refundable.
- II) Syllabus for entrance examination
 - B.Sc. I 15%
 - B.Sc. II 15%
 - B.Sc. III 70 %
- III) Merit list weightage
 - B.Sc. III 50% (Excluding English)
 - Entrance Exam 50%
- IV) Entrance examination centre:
 - Vivekanand College, Kolhapur Time: 12:00 noon To 1:30 p.m.
- V) Fees for Entrance Examination: As per notification
- VI) Document Submission: (At the time of final admission)
 - B.Sc. III final mark-list
 - Caste Certificate
 - Other required Documents
- VII) Payment of the Entrance examination: The student can pay fee through payment gateway OR directly at the college office during working hours.
- VIII) There shall be an admission committee for proper monitoring of admissions. The admission committee shall be constituted as under:
 - Principal (Chairperson)
 - Head of the concerned department
 - One senior teacher in the department
 - Registrar
 - Accountant
- IX) For preparing merit list committee shall consider the marks obtained at the third year examination and the marks obtained at entrance examination.
- X) The reservation quota will be as per rules of government of Maharashtra and Shivaji University Kolhapur.
- XI) Other university students shall be given admissions on entrance examination merit only.

- XII) If any seat remains vacant from the quota, students in order of merit list shall be admitted from the waiting list.
- XIII) A student shall be held eligible for admission to the M.Sc. course provided, he/she has passed B.Sc. /B.A. examination either with principle subject or with subsidiary/ interdisciplinary/ applied subjects and has passed the entrance examination conducted by the college.
- XIV) The students with B.Sc. from other universities shall be eligible if they qualify through entrance examination and they score minimum 55% mark in the subject at B.Sc.
- XV) While preparing the merit list for M.Sc. admission the performance at B.Sc. III and the performance at the entrance examination will be given equal weightage.
