Item no. 2: To approve the course structures of all the programmes/specific programmes finalized by the concerned BoSs.

The BoS chairmen of all the departments presented the structure of the third-year syllabi along with the evaluation system as per the PSOs. These course structures were accepted and approved by the Academic council after minor changes or suggestions.

Item no.3: To discuss and decide on the introduction of Skill Enhancement Courses (SECs)

It was decided that all the departments will introduce SECs at Semester III, IV, V & VI. At Sem III and IV level, there will be 2 SECs offered related to the two DSCs opted by the students (for 2 credits each). At Sem V and VI level, 1 SEC for 4 credits will be offered related to the DSEs. Accordingly, total 8 credits will be assigned to the SECs and the exams will be taken annually. Students have to complete these courses through SSM (self-study mode).

Item no. 4: To approve the continuation of Environmental Studies as AECC for the second year of all the programmes.

1. Separate BoS for BBA and BCA

Commerce and Computer Science, along with the temporary staff members.
